**The author didn't say so, but I'll bet that...**

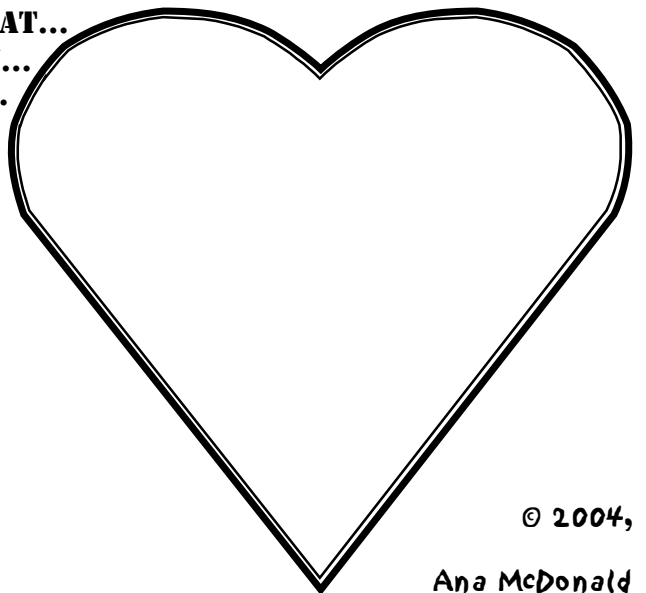

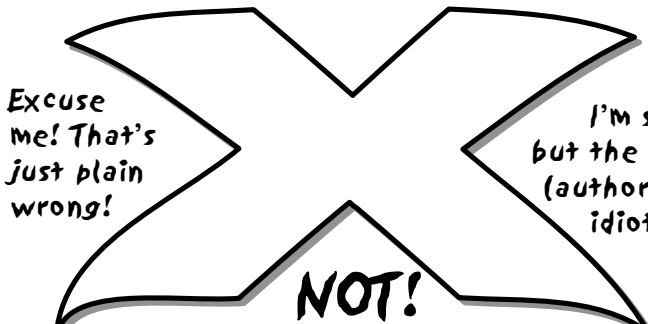
