Treasurer's Report ...

Dues are Due

Please pay outstanding 2003 tournament dues by the January meeting. Milton needs to close the books for 2003. TABC dues are due by the January meeting (\$20.00 per year). In order to be eligible to compete in the TABC State Tournament, a CBC member **must** be a TABC member. CBC 2004 dues are due by the January meeting. The CBC dues are \$18.00 (six months) or \$36.00 per year. **Please see Treasurer Milton Thompson for any outstanding dues owed.**

CBC Business...

New Members

John Powers, who fished the CBC Open Tournament in October 2003, visited the CBC at the November meeting and fished the December tournament at Fayette County. John was voted into the club at the December meeting. Please welcome John as a new member of the CBC. John's contact information will be included in an updated version of the address and phone list.

Annual Awards Banquet

A discussion was led by President Tim Cook regarding the potential location and date of the CBC Annual Awards Banquet. Suggestions were made by CBC members to hold the banquet at Mamacita's and have a fajita dinner like the CBC has done the last two years. It was also suggested that the CBC might consider having the banquet as a separate event not associated with a regular CBC meeting. A recommendation was made to have President-elect Lance Wenmohs appoint a committee to research the potential location and date of the Annual Awards Banquet.

Paper Tournament Length Measurement Standardization

President Tim Cook presented the idea of standardizing the measurement of bass at CBC Paper Tournaments. This idea was spurred by the likely chance of a CBC member catching a bass over 22-inches at Fayette County. The current measuring board used by CBC members is the "Golden Rule Weigh Master" largemouth bass measuring board, which has the capability of measuring bass up to 22-inches in 1/8-inch increments. Tim suggested that the CBC members purchase (or the CBC purchase for each member???) the "Golden Rule Weigh Master" walleye measuring board, which has the capability of measuring bass up to 25-inches in 1/8-inch increments. B.A.S.S. State Tournament Entry Fee Change

The Texas B.A.S.S. Federation has changed the entry fee for the Annual State Tournament. The entry fee has increased from \$400.00 to 490.00 per six man team. The increase occurred due to the Texas B.A.S.S. Federation incorporating the "optional Big Bass pot", which is no longer optional into the entry fee. Historically, each participating CBC member paid a \$5.00 per day fee to enter the "Big Bass Pot". The CBC members voted in favor of the club paying the entry fee including the "Big Bass Pot" portion for both the B.A.S.S. State Tournament and TABC State Tournament.

Sportsman of the Year Nominations

Carl Adkins and **Tim Cook** have been nominated for the *Sportsman of the Year Award*. The Sportsman of the Year will be voted on at the January meeting by secret ballot and announced at the *CBC Annual Awards Banquet*.

WINNING DETAILS...

Michael Tennant with 5 bass for 17.91 lbs.

Lures: Yo-Zuri Hardcore Drum (Painted Shad) and War Eagle ¼ ounce spinner bait (Blue Shad).

Tackle: 15-pound-test Ande clear monofilament; 6-6 medium action BPS Extreme rod and Pflueger Supreme reel (same rod and reel combo for both lures).

Technique: Targeting aquatic vegetation (marine naiad) in 2 to 8 feet of water I used an unorthodox retrieve technique to trigger the bass to bite. I burned the lipless crank bait with a high-speed reel and when the bait contacted or bogged up in the marine naiad I would rip the bait (literally set the hook I was ripping it so hard) out of the vegetation. My bites would come when the bait would bust loose and begin to fall. I had 9 bites and boated 8 bass all keepers. Four (4) of the 5 bass weighed were caught on the Yo-Zuri bait and 1 of the 5 bass were caught burning the spinner bait. I would like to thank Stan Miller for putting in the prefishing time and finding areas with bass. Catching fish is easy! The hard part is finding them. Thanks Stan!

RUNNERS-UP...

2nd Place: Stan Miller with 4 bass for 15.15 lbs.

Lures: Rattle-L-Trap ¼ ounce (Bleeding Shiner) and Rattle-L-Trap ¾ ounce floating (Red)

Tackle: 15-pound-test P-line; 6-6 medium action All Star rod and BPS Extreme reel (¼ ounce trap); 12/24 Fusion line; 7-0 medium action All Star rod and BPS PQ1000 reel (¾ ounce floating trap).

Technique: Same as winning technique. Stan boated 4 bass and had 9 bites.

3rd Place: Milton Thompson with 4 bass for 11.96 lbs.

Lures: Yo-Zuri Lipless crank bait (Ghost Shad), Zoom Super Fluke (Watermelon Red), and **Carl's Worm-** 7" Berkley Power Worm (Motor oil)

Tackle: 15-pound-test Berkley Big Game; 7-0 medium heavy action BPS Extreme rod and Shimano Curado reel

Technique: Milton caught 2 bass ripping (*similar technique as described by Michael Tennant*) a lipless crank bait. He boated 2 more keepers on two different soft plastics. All bass were caught fishing shallow grass and pond dams. Milton's biggest bass (23.5-inches) was caught on a Super Fluke from a ball of grass 2' in diameter, which was located in the back of an unnamed cove. When interviewed Milton had a story to tell and it went something like this.... Carl and Milton prefished together for the tournament and during their prefishing outing Carl set the hook into a fish and busted the fish off. There is really nothing out of the ordinary to this story so far. But, on tournament day Milton returned to this same area and this time Milton got bit, set the hook, fought the bass to the boat, and landed the bass. Upon further inspection of the bass Milton noticed a small piece of line hanging from the bass' mouth. He followed the line into the mouth of the bass and discovered Carl's worm hook from their prefishing outing. The bass was an 18-incher added to Milton's bag. Who said recently hooked bass will not bite??

Notes and Quotes from the tournament...

Prior to the tournament a few CBC members caught their personal best "five" bass limits. Congratulations!! The December tournament weights were not near as good as those reported during prefishing. However, seven members managed to weigh-in more than 10 pounds. Not too bad for December fishing!! There were 22 members and three guests that fished the tournament. We caught 48 bass weighing 146.76 pounds, which translates into 0.27 bass caught per hour, or two bass for every eight hours of fishing. Only two five bass limits were weighed. The average bass weighed 3.06 pounds.

Check the standings! The December tournament changed the Top Six Rankings.

Unfortunately, I do not have any quotes to share for this newsletter because I did not know if I was going to pen this issue of the CBC newsletter. I guess I was hoping someone else would get the job. I will try to incorporate a few quotes in future newsletters. However, from the talk amongst CBC members I think the buzzword for the December tournament was the "Rippin' Technique".
