## **CBC Business...**

### **TABC, President Attends October Meeting**

Dr. Bud Wright, TABC President, attended the October meeting to swap second and third place 2004 TABC State Tournament trophies. A few questions were asked by the CBC membership regarding the organization of the 2004 TABC State Tournament and the future direction of TABC as an organization. I decided not include the Q&A discussion for brevity of this newsletter. For those CBC members unable to attend the October meeting who have questions or comments please contact the 2004 CBC Officers.

Dr. Bud Wright announced the location and month of the 2005 TABC State Tournament. The 2005 TABC State Tournament will be held in September on Belton and Stillhouse Hollow Reservoirs. Each team of the four (4) boat team will fish one day on each reservoir. For example, the first day two boats from "Team 1" will fish Belton and two boats from "Team 1" will fish Stillhouse Hollow and the second day the two boats from "Team 1" that fished Belton will fish Stillhouse Hollow and the two boats from "Team 1" that fished Stillhouse will fish Belton.

### **CBC Open Tournament**

Gary Swenson, Co-Chairman confirmed/finalized CBC Open Tournament work assignments for October 30, 2004, tournament day and thanked all the members for their participation in the planning and organization of the 2004 CBC Open Tournament.

### **CBC December Two-Day Tournament**

The CBC will hold a second two-day tournament in December on Fayette County Reservoir. For those of you interested in overnight lodging, Stan Miller and I have put together a list of area accommodations:

1. LCRA Oak Thicket Park has eight (8) furnished cabins (4) Efficiencies sleep up to four people @ \$79.50/night (these cabins only have two (2) double beds), (2) Two bed room cabins sleep up to six @ \$132.50/night, and (2) Bunkhouses sleep up to 14 @ \$143.10 per night. All cabins have heat and A/C, bed and bath linens, satellite TV, coffee maker, small refrigerator, microwave and bathrooms. There are also picnic tables, grills and campfire rings outside. The two-bedroom and bunkhouse include their own kitchenettes for cooking indoors.

For campers with RV's and tents, Oak Thicket Park offers 20 campsites with water and electric hookups. Four of these sites have 50 amp electric hookups for those larger RV's. There are 20 campsites with 30 or 50 amp electric hookups and water. 30 amp sites are \$16.00/night and 50 amp sites are \$17.00/night. Restrooms and showers are available. Oak Thicket offers eight screened shelters with electricity, water, ceiling fans, picnic table, grill and fire rings for \$26.00/night.

Reservations must be made 48 hours in advance by calling the TPWD Reservation Center at (512)-389-8900. There is a \$5.00 service charge for these reservations and \$10.00 cancellation charge for your reservation up to two days before your arrival. The \$4.00/person/day park entry is also required of cabin and camping guests. To make reservations less than 48 hours in advance call the park at (979) 249-3504. Oak Thicket has a two night minimum stay for cabin rentals.

Fusion line. Worm -- Falcon rod 7 ft. medium heavy, model FC-5-17, with a Bass Pro Shops Pro Qualifier Reel, model PQR 1000S, with a 5.0 to 1 gear ratio along with 20 lb. P-Line Floroclear copolymer line, a 1/8 oz. Lake Fork Tungsten Mega-Weight bullet sinker and a 3.5/0 Eagle Claw Featherlite hook.

**Technique:** Stan caught three of his "keeper bass" early before sunrise off the dam in water depths of 2 to 5 feet by throwing the black/blue spinnerbait to the shallow water and slow rolling the bait back to the boat trying to stay in contact with the grass and rocks. His other two "keeper bass" were caught in the middle of the day on a Texas-rigged worm off the outside edge of an isolated grass patch in about 8 to 10 feet of water about 50 yards down from the cold water inlet. With the above five (5) fish, Stan was able to cull 4 smaller "keeper bass" that he had caught during the day using a variety of other baits which included a 1/2 oz Rattle Trap, a small shallow running crankbait, a Fluke and a Snagless Sally in-line spinnerbait.

## **RUNNERS-UP...**

***2<sup>nd</sup> Place: Lance Wenmohs with 5 bass for 13.45 lbs.***

**Lures:** Terminator Spinnerbait (White 3/8 oz. w/ duel willow leaf blades); Berkley 8-inch magnum lizard (green pumpkin) fished on TX rig; Zoom Baby Brush Hog (watermelon/red) fished on Carolina Rig; Yamamoto Senko (5-inch moss) fished weightless on 3/0 Gamakatsu wide gap hook.

**Tackle:** 12 and 15 pound test Berkley Vanish line. 7' 6" heavy action All Star Carolina Rig Rod with Shimano Calcutta reel – Carolina Rig baby brush hog; 6' 9" medium action Kistler Spinner bait rod with Shimano Chronarch reel – spinner bait; 6' 6" medium heavy All Star Emerald Series worm rod with Shimano Chronarch reel – TX Rig lizard; and 6' 6" medium heavy Shimano rod with Shimano Chronarch reel - Senko

**Technique:** Lance fished the large cove located by the intake early and late. He fished the large wind blown cove next to the boat ramp during the middle part of the day. Early, before the sun came up, he fished the shallow grass and concrete bank with the TX Rig 8-inch worm and spinner bait, picking up three keepers. Once the sun came up, he switched to the Senko and Carolina Rigged baby brush hog and picked up keepers in the grass. His largest fish came around 8:00 am from the channel that is located at the intake. Lance caught 9 fish over 14 inches and 3 smaller fish during the day.

***3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Milton Thompson with 5 bass for 13.27 lbs.***

**Lures:** Berkley Power Worm (motor oil) Texas rigged

**Tackle:** Waterloo rod, Shimano reel, 15lb Big Game line, 1/4oz tungsten weight, Red 3/0 EWG hook.

**Technique:** Milton caught his five bass pitching to reeds in coves and edges of the grass line near the hot water outlet.

## **Notes and Quotes from the tournament...**

Twenty two (22) members and one (1) guest fished the tournament. The CBC caught 75 bass weighing 155.95 pounds, which translates into 0.36 bass caught per hour or approximately 3.0 bass for every eight hours of fishing. Seven (7) five bass limits were weighed. The average bass weighed 2.08 pounds.
