CBC members, dues are due!! CBC members please see Milton Thompson, Treasurer for any outstanding CBC dues or tournament fees. As stated in the CBC Constitution and Policies Section 4: Eligibility, CBC dues are due by the September meeting. lure. Basically there was no retrieve, just cast it to the edge of the visible grass and let it sit still for several seconds and then just barely move the bait. The fish would then just take the lure down (no splash just a slurp) and all he had to do was hold on.

**Technique:** Mike reported no pattern to his success, just some luck of being in the right place at the right time. He reported catching his 4 bass from both the hot water and cool water side of the lake near "grass".

***3<sup>rd</sup> Place: Mike Katzer 5 bass for 10.79 lbs.***

**Lures:** Zoom Super Fluke Jr.(color unknown); swim bait (manufacturer unknown); Roadrunner jig; and top water (manufacturer unknown)

**Tackle:** unknown

**Technique:** Mike reported catching "schooling bass" early to fill his five bass limit.

## **Notes and Quotes from the tournament...**

Twenty seven (27) members fished the tournament. This is the largest CBC tournament attendance this year. The CBC caught 40 bass weighing 100.60 pounds, which translates into 0.19 bass caught per hour or approximately 1.5 bass for every eight hours of fishing. Three (3) five bass limits were weighed. The average bass weighed 2.52 pounds. A **Big Thank You** to David Hoedebeck for providing watermelon at the weigh-in. Tournament day proved to be tougher than expected, as school was out. Mike Katzer was the only member to capitalize on the very limited schooling activity. Stan Miller caught ten keepers on topwater before 8:00 am.
