Preston Bean, who received the CBC scholarship this year, and his wife delivered a presentation on Guadalupe bass research that is being conducted. Preston is working on his master's degree under Dr. Tim Bonner at TSU.

The club discussed the need to acquire some better weigh in bags. Many of the current CBC weigh bags have holes in them. The club voted to purchase 10 new weigh bags to replace the old ones. Tim Cook will take the lead on acquiring the new bags.

Constitution/Policy Amendment Time—Here's How it Works

Club members wishing to amend the constitution or policies must present to the Club President before the July regular meeting a written amendment which clearly states the proposed change in the form of a motion. At the July meeting the Club President will read the proposed amendment and call for a second from the membership. If seconded, the membership will have the opportunity to discuss the proposed amendment. A majority vote by the membership present at the July meeting will decide whether or not the amendment shall be "considered".

The "considered" amendment(s) which are carried during the July meeting will be published in the following month's Club newsletter so that all members become aware of the proposed changes. During the August meeting a final vote will be taken on the proposed changes as written in the Club's published newsletter and at this time no discussion will be heard. Passage of the proposed amendment will require a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the members present during the August meeting. could be paired up by draw. The members discussed this and voted to have a draw tournament for the June event. The draw will occur at the launch ramp and is not mandatory.

Lures: Pop R top water; 4" Zoom centipede fished on a drop shot rig with a #2 Gama-Gatsu wide gap hook; 6" Zoom trick worm fished on a 3/16 oz jig head.

Tackle: 10lb test Berkley Transition fluorocarbon and 12lb test P Line copolymer. 7' medium heavy action Falcon rod with Shimano spinning reel – drop shot rig; 7' medium heavy Falcon rod with Shimano Curado reel – jig head

Technique: John started out fishing in the Turkey Cove area and caught one nice smallmouth that weighted about 3 lbs early in the morning on a top water lure. He then switched to fishing a drop shot rig and jig head worm along the deep drop-offs. John caught a total of 6 keepers and a number of smaller fish.
