#### **Summary of fishing techniques for the top three spots at Fayette County tournament:**

##### **1<sup>st</sup> place Greg Cummings (26.27 lbs)**

Morning: Horny Toad (and similar style) baits along reeds. Watermelon seed and Watermelon Red/Pearl colors.

Midday/Afternoon: Deep cranking offshore humps with Hot Lips Express 3/4 oz. in Moon Glow and Texas Shad/Crystal

##### **2<sup>nd</sup> place Stan Miller(19.03 lbs)**

Stan caught a limit early throwing a red trap in shallow water in the Three Fingers Area. Later in the day he fished 15 ft water at a point near the Prairie Thicket Park area with a 10 inch red shad worm on a Carolina Rig.

**3<sup>rd</sup> place Bobby Whiteside (16.20 lbs)**

Swenson and I tried the aquatic vegetation 3 different times during the day and Gary got two 14 inch bass on traps and I got one keeper on a fluke and broke another keeper off on a fluke. At 10:20 am we started fishing the dam and by 12:00 noon I had 6 keepers and Gary had 2. We tried the dam again about 2:00 pm for about 1 hour and Gary caught 2 more keepers and I caught one more. We caught the fish on the dam with Jr. flukes on weighted hooks and super flukes on weighted hooks. I fished 8 and 10 lb fluorocarbon line. We mainly used some type of watermelon colored flukes. I caught one keeper on a Texas rigged brushhog flipping into the cattails.
